MIDGLEY RECREATION GROUND - UDDATE

During the summer we applied for a grant to renovate the Recreation Ground. Unfortunately we were unsuccessful in our bid. We now have to look at other funding possibilities and this will also mean that the renovations will have to be completed in stages. We are therefore proposing the following time scales:-

The picnic area of the project which will be funded by monies Calderdale Council have already allocated to the project. This will take place as soon as the Safer Greener Cleaner Department of Calderdale Council can arrange the works, together with the renovation of the existing equipment already on the rec.

The next stage of the project will be to start the younger children's part of the play area. This will include some of the pieces of equipment chosen by the children, the relevant matting under the equipment and the fencing so that the children can play in a safe area.

*This stage will be funded by Midgley Community Forum and MMAL from existing monies, and will be completed in time for next year's FETE.

For the remainder of the project, in addition to further contributions from Midgley Community Forum and MMAL as we continue to generate funds, we will look into the possibilities of obtaining smaller grants, sponsorship/donations from the local business community, and the children from Midgley School Council are to come up with some fund raising ideas.

*We already have collection boxes in the shop, the school and the Lord Nelson in Luddenden, for anyone who would like to donate.

*The aim is to have the whole project completed by 2025 which is the one hundreth anniversary of the Recreation Ground being gifted to the community.
